Notes

This software does not support the "Clock Source" function in the Audio/MIDI Setup of Mac OS X (Core Audio), though it could be selected from the Core Audio control panel.

Notes for Handling Digital Audio

When setting the Clock Source to "External", the operations below could stop your system (with the pointer changing into a colorful spinning disc).

- Changing the Frequency setting on the Core Audio control panel.
- Changing the Frequency setting on a project file of the DAW software.
- Opening a project file of DAW software that has a different Frequency setting.

In these cases, the problem can be solved by sending a digital audio signal with the same Frequency as that set on the Core Audio control panel.

- Opening a Cubase project file by directly clicking the project file.

In this case, take care to open a project file from the Cubase "File" menu after you have launched Cubase.
